

**GREAT NECK ESTATES - NOTICE OF ADOPTION  
OF LOCAL LAW SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a regular meeting duly held on November 12, 2018, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Great Neck Estates, New York (the "Village") duly adopted a local law, an abstract of which follows, which local law is subject to a permissive referendum pursuant to Article 3 and Article 9 of the Village Law of the State of New York.

Local Law 3 of 2018. A local law to amend the Code of the Village of Great Neck Estates, in relation to the terms of office for Mayor, Trustees and Village Justices. This local law will change the terms of office for Mayor and Trustees in the Village from two years to four years, commencing with the positions to be elected at the March 2019 general village election. At the 2019 general village election, the positions of Mayor, Trustee and Village Justice will be filled for terms of four years. At the 2020 general Village election, the positions of Mayor and Trustee will be filled for terms of five years each. At the 2021 general Village election, the position of Village Justice will be filled for a term of four years. Thereafter, Village general elections will be held biennially in odd-numbered years.
